THE BVI'S



THE BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS ARE A TRUE YACHTING PARADISE, WITH VOLCANIC, JUNGLE-COVERED PEAKS SLOPING DOWN TO SUGAR WHITE BEACHES, AND SANDY CORAL ATOLLS WITH WAVING COCONUT PALMS CREATING THE DESERT ISLAND EXPERIENCE OF YOUR DREAMS.

As a yacht charter destination, the BVIs are almost impossible to beat, with over 50 pretty islands scattered like lush gems across the turquoise sea. The islands are located within a short distance of each other, making cruising effortless, and the BVIs offer a multitude of stunning anchorages as well as glamorous superyacht marinas. Providing excellent shelter and calm, crystal clear seas, the BVIs also receive the Caribbean trade winds, making the archipelago a famously good sailing ground as well as a great place for thrilling water sports like kitesurfing.

On a BVIs yacht charter, there is something for everyone. Dive the wreck of the HMS Rhone off Salt Beach, one of the great dives of the Caribbean, or snorkel through the Virgin Gorda Baths, where huge granite boulders create a glimmering playground of sapphire lagoons and ethereal grottos. Hike up to Virgin Gorda Peak for breath-taking views of the archipelago, or horse ride along a beach in Tortola, coconuts washing up on the shore. Strap on your dive tank and make your way along the unforgettable Wreck Alley, where airplanes and boats have been submerged for divers, or just drink coconuts and read books in a hammock in dreamy Trunk Bay. The BVIs are incredibly, deeply peaceful, with no Jet Skis allowed to break the tranquil vibe of lapping sea and afternoon breezes. On the glorious coral atoll of Anegada, explore the 16 miles of powder soft beaches, and watch flamingos stalk across the flats, bright pink against sand and sky. Anegada is surrounded by the incredible Horseshoe Reef, where hundreds of shipwrecks litter the seabed, and a kaleidoscope of fish creates waves of colour in the sunlit sea.





NORMAN ISLAND

Day 1

Anchored in an area called "The Bight". Referred to as the "Treasure Island", legends of Norman Island are replete with stories of buried pirate treasure.

A quick tender ride will bring you to the moorings at Treasure Point. Excellent snorkeling along the mouth of four caves boasting colorful reef fish and great exploring.



JOST VAN DYKE

Day 2

Anchor in Manchioneel Bay, Little Jost Van Dyke. This location offers several activities. Short tender ride to the dock at Foxy's Taboo, a charming restaurant with a light breezy atmosphere. A short trail hike brings you to a natural pool at the oceans edge known as the "Bubbly Pool". Sandy Spit is a beautiful beach plus the world-famous Soggy Dollar Bar is only a short tender ride away.





GUANA ISLAND

Day 3

Enjoy a short cruise to White Bay, Guana Island. Here off of the southern tip lies Monkey Point.

Boasting small beach areas great for snorkeling guests can enjoy paddle boarding and relaxing on the long stretch of the white sandy beach.





THE BATHS

Day 4

Drop anchor in The Baths and take a short tender ride ashore where large formations of granite boulders are scattered and stacked on a beautiful sandy beach.

Trails weave throughout the rocks in and out of pools with sunlight gleaming through the rocks creating what will be some of the best pictures of the trip. Weigh anchor and have a nice lunch cruise to The North Sound of Virgin Gorda.



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
